Get the most out of your web images using the features in Adobe Photoshop CS6 and Adobe Fireworks CS6. Learn how to use the Save for Web feature in Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Fireworks, select appropriate file formats for particular image types and how to best optimize each format. You will use Adobe Fireworks to build web page elements, create and edit vector and bitmap images and to import and modify native Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Illustrator files. You will learn to add depth and character to text and symbols by applying effects, styles, and blend modes and to creatively design interactive layouts for websites and rich Internet applications. In addition, you will export website comps to Adobe Dreamweaver as standards-compliant, CSS-based layouts.
